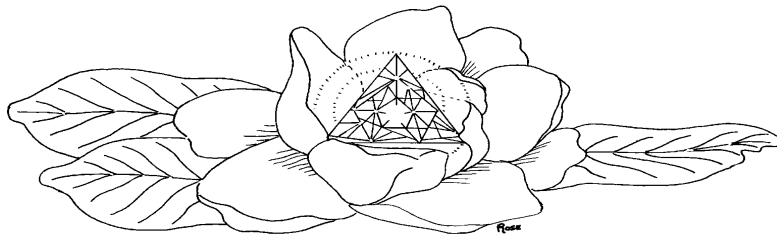

The Economics of Equality

Note: An Ignoromist, as opposed to an economist, is a person who is basically ignorant or not aware of the synthetic, harmonious, multidimensional nature of Reality and who generates economic theories based on their illusory conceptions of Reality.

Over the past 5000 years of recorded history legions of ignoromists mired in the delusion of the Divine Rights of the powerful and propertied, including the contemporary master sophist and ignoromist, Milton Friedman, have created a bleak and tortured landscape where Equality and Liberty have struggled to maintain even a slight foothold in the planet's effort to evolve.

I really admire and am truly grateful—as should be all of the non-exclusive, non-privileged, and non-capitol owning humans on the planet—for the efforts made by a long series of Heroes on behalf of Humanity. In the realm of economics, for example we have the 18th century economists like John Stuart Mill, and Karl Marx. The much maligned by the Power Elite, Karl Marx, was among the first to actually reveal the scope and depth of the ancient, and deliberately created and sophistically maintained cleavage between the power elite and the rest of humanity. Lately, we can be thankful for the huge efforts that John Maynard Keynes and their contemporaries, like Paul Krugman, and Thomas Piketty have made and are making to bring light and a measure of sanity into the economic chaos of the planet.

It is such efforts by those who have hearts and some compassion for Humanity in all areas of human enterprise that has actually maintained our presence on the planet for this long. However, many of those, especially in the role of political and economic theory also seem to be imprisoned by the ancient, illusory thoughtforms of a one dimensional materialistic reality which are embodied in the Divine Right of the powerful to rule and which lie at the core of our present civilizations.

Why Economics Failed

In a recent *New York Times* column entitled “Why Economics Failed”, Paul Krugman concludes that basic economic theories such as the essential nature of circulation of income or energy through the system were more or less deliberately ignored resulting in the economic situation we now call the 1%. “Meanwhile, powerful political factions find that bad economic analysis serves their objectives. Most obviously, people whose real goal is dismantling the social safety net have found promoting deficit panic an effective way to push their agenda. And such people have been aided and abetted by what I’ve come to think of as the *trahison des nerds* — the willingness of some economists to come up with analyses that tell powerful people what they want to hear,....”

Of course, sophists, to use a more accurate identifier than the cute one Mr. Krugman chose, are nothing new. The willingness of the court sycophants to produce intelligent sounding and

appearing fog to support their masters delusions is as old as the basic flaws in the system. Imagine, for example, what would have happened to an advisor of Pope Paul V who told the Pope that Galileo was right, or someone who told, say Henry 8, that Kings were not really divine, and the people of England were not really his "subjects."


"Scientists" that prove that tobacco smoking is healthy and that Global warming is a myth are a dime a dozen, as are ignoromists who willingly spin webs of illusion to justify the divine right of the wealthy. Propensity for profit over any sort of morality is an intrinsic, organic aspect of the system. Avarice generated the latest "crash", and you can be sure that this is not the first time it happened. Avarice generated the "Great Depression", and avarice is the energy that drove the onslaught of so called "Supply Side Economics, that has almost obliterated the advances made in human rights. Why anyone is surprised that these "crashes" have happened and will continue to happen is what I find amazing.

Five thousand years of experience, indicates that the ideological foundations of our present civilization guarantee the inevitability of such collapse. The system "fixes" that the economists like Krugman

and Piketty suggest, although often short term pain relievers, will likewise eventually fail. The separations of wealth and poverty will reappear and living conditions for the non-owners of capital will deteriorate once again.

It is this basic "ownership" and directional control of the Planetary Economy or Life Force by the world's elite that generate these retrogressive impediments in the evolutionary development of the Planet. "Money" is a concrete manifestation of the system's Life blood or energy. Sucking huge amounts of this energy from the system in the form of rewards or euphemistically "profits" for investing or "making bets" and hording it in secret bank accounts creates blood clots in the planet's circulation system with all of the results of blood clots in any system. What money is released is directed to the extent possible away from the support of the Common Good and into the hands of the powerful few that generate and maintain the inequality or imbalance so obvious on the planet.

It is important to be conscious of the fact that where Planetary Economy is concerned, national sovereignty, things like borders or customs mean nothing. There are members of the exclusive power elite in every country who are supported by numerous ignoromists willing to supply intellectual and seeming

The Collapse of Public Education

In the U.S. a graphic example of the manipulative power of this control can be seen in the many thousands of publicly supported elementary and secondary schools. While never really great, these schools were at least adequate. However, in the last 25 to 30 years the Common Wealth has been increasingly redirected through the implementation of supply side economics into the coffers of the controlling oligarchs. Thus, starved for resources, many, many public schools have become woefully inadequate.

The schools frequently lack functioning physical premises. Books, if they exist at all, are few, outdated, and beat-up. Tools, like paper and pencils, are scarce. Audio/visual equipment is like the book, outdated and broken. Art and supplies if they exist do so because a teacher supplied them from her wages.


And the teachers: They that are there are outnumbered. Many of them, faced daily with overwhelming class sizes, and loads of extreme social issues such as frequently abused, hungry, and sleepy, and often, drugged children are, totally discouraged. It is a wonder that any learning takes place at all.

Mostly these "schools" serve as parking lots for poor children who emerge after ten to twelve years of non-education almost illiterate. This is great for the power elite. Because of advancing technology, which they "own", they actually want and need far fewer well educated, thinking individuals. There is no such thing as equality for these children let alone the ignomist shibboleth of "equal opportunity".

It is these ancient, illusory thoughtforms of a one dimensional materialistic reality which is so embodied in the Divine Right of the powerful to rule which lie at the core of our present civilizations and which generate poverty, illiteracy, disease and war in the human kingdom. These ancient notions of rulership and ownership also lie at the root of our planetary ecosystem disasters as well. These events occur with various level of devastation on a daily basis. The ongoing Fukushima nuclear incident is just one example of such greed driven economics.

Why, I keep wondering? Why is it so difficult, to realize that our good intentioned efforts even if they are finally implemented, will have little if any hope of correcting the problems. Consider what happened to Elizabeth Warren's efforts to protect the consumers.

aspects of an economic system, actually reveal the illusory premises of the one dimensional materialistic illusion of reality upon which the systems rest.

In a system that is grounded in equality, in a system that operates in a realized multidimensional, synthetic cosmos where a basic principle of Cosmic Physics is the cooperative circulation of life or energy through the entire organism toward the maintenance and health of the General Welfare and the Common Good of the whole organism, there is no need for a "safety net" or consumer protection. This is so even if we are talking about a Solar System or Galaxy. ***"It is known that Good can come only from Good."*** *Supermundane II, 267.*

As the apologizer and deluded "centrist" David Brooks has observed, "If the left takes it up, they are marching onto a bridge to nowhere." Mr. Brooks is referring to Thomas Piketty's recent book [Capital in the Twenty-First Century](#). In this refreshing book, Mr. Piketty has suggested a remarkable solution to the present unavoidable appearance of gross inequality, this time in income, which is an always present cornerstone of the system. Not, I suspect for the reasons that Mr. Brooks holds, but his words regarding a bridge to nowhere are prophetic. A simple review of just the last 200 years of this Nation's history, will


reveal that we are on a merry-go-round that goes just about nowhere.

Consider:

We struggle mightily to bring some sort of improvement and change. Take for example the abolition of overt slavery in this country. This effort cost the people four years of struggle, untold suffering, some 700,000 plus combat and civilian dead and the murder of a Hero, our President.

The "victory" was a triumph for common sense otherwise known as right human relations, and a huge blow to the mindset that drives the programmatic efforts of the Ignoromists. This mindset assumes, with self effacing back slapping, and congratulations that it is imperative for the good of lesser beings, the serfs and slaves, that the rich and powerful, the owners of capital or assets, provide opportunities for them, to see that they have jobs and food and work in this way. The bloody action of the Civil War was a necessary and a great step forward toward Equality, and for the Common Good, and General Welfare

We need to note that it took another 60 or 70 years of struggle and sacrifice for women to break free from some level of their bondage, to gain a small measure of Equality, the right to vote, and another 85 years to desegregate public schools.

But the merry-go-round goes around. Today for example, the public schools are being rapidly re-segregated, still along racial lines but much more so along class and money lines. The current euphuism for this kind of segregation is Charter Schools and Private Schools. Instead of fostering excellent education for all of the children, we create a few exclusive schools here and there, frequently as profit making businesses. The "competition" to have one's children attend those schools is fierce. Needless to say those with the most means, that is, euphemistically opportunity, but actually money and social position "win".

Meanwhile, slavery has simply moved on, changed its clothes, so to speak. The Plantations which were the "New World" offspring of Earldoms and Dukedoms have "evolved" with the industrial revolution into Corporations, "big box" retailers of all sorts. For example, instead of cotton, we have Goldman Sachs farming currency, credit default swaps, and other metaphysicals which are much more profitable crops. Then there is the multination Murdoch's News Corporation, which cultivates fear mongering, half-truths, and outright lies to create a sink or market in which it can unload almost anything, and many others.

As Mr. Sterling, the Owner of the Clippers, a Los Angeles professional basketball franchise when asked about the fact that most of the players were black, observed, "I support them and give them food, and clothes, and cars, and houses....". These comments were widely seen as racist, which they most obviously were. However, the attitudes and assumptions behind those comments mirror the same attitude or mindset expressed by many, many owners of capital towards anybody or group regardless of race, religion, sex that they see as inferior to themselves.


The forms have changed, however, the delusory assumptions of divine right, superiority and exclusivity, remain constant.

I could give several dozen other examples of how practically every step Humanity has been able to take toward a just and equal society has failed, or been ignored or even manipulated to work in reverse of its intention. If 200 years is too long, look at the period from the inauguration of Ronald Reagan as President to the end of the Bush dynasty. The advance in civil rights, made at the expense, I might point out, of the murder of 3 more compassionate hearts, one of whom was a President, during the Kennedy and Johnson presidencies have been all but obliterated.

For all intents and purposes, the plantation owners already control the economy. Their current offensive which has been underway for some fourteen years is to regain total control of the actual government which they semi lost six years ago. They are campaigning now to destroy the freedom of voting by manipulating the voting processes, in one way or another, to rig the electronic voting equipment, to prevent qualified individuals from voting and to make the process of voting as onerous, time consuming and discouraging as possible for those who do vote. Their intention is to make this control of the government permanent.

It's basically back to the 1400's where people of quality ran the program and had private little wars.

In his review of Piketty's *Capital in the Twenty-First Century*, Mr. Krugman observes that, "Basically, Piketty sees economic history as the story of a race between capital accumulation and other factors driving growth, mainly population growth and technological progress. To be sure, this is a race that can have no permanent victor over the very long run, the stock of capital and total income must grow at roughly the same rate. But one side or the other can pull ahead for decades at a time."



Any further attempt to fix this insane situation without dealing with the underlying CAUSES will fail as has all of the previous efforts.

The reasons for this bizarre eons long trip around merry-go-round is explained by both the economists—even the ones with compassion and heart such as Paul Krugman, and the ignoromists who are not only clueless but heartless as well—through an analysis of previous event trips around the merry-go-round. They examine events, and never, ever ask why? They never examine the causes that drive these redundant events. And so they do not see even the events very well. For example, Mr. Krugman does not observe, that it does not really matter which, "capital accumulation or total income" is ahead because they are both the same thing, power, in different forms, and that the Plantation Owners own both.

Actually, the history of economics on this planet, is inseparable from the history of government and human relations, both of which offer another view of the very long and sad story. This view is the history of the causes of the effects which we usually think of as history but are only a history of the results or effects of the domination of human thinking by an illusion regarding the nature of Reality. The assumptions that we live in a one dimensional reality in which power and wealth are the bedrock and generators of value and meaning, that freedom means that we are free to amass in whatever way we can and claim through Devine right, exclusive, private ownership of as

much of the planet's resources as possible including the lives and labor of other humans is the delusion that has been driving the government, economics and human relations of the planet.

Any further attempt to fix this insane situation without dealing with the underlying CAUSES will fail as has all of the previous efforts. There is only one way to "fix" the delusions that spring from illusions and that is to dissipate the illusion and begin to formulate systems of economics, government, human relations, on the Real World.

How To Do This

To Begin, we need to shift our point of view from effects to causes. We need to ask why every effort to correct the imbalances which are so apparent in virtually all of the systems of civilization, fails. As soon as we examine the ancient thoughtforms and underlying controlling shibboleths regarding the nature of human life and value in the light of modern science, their superficial absurdity will become apparent.

Secondly, we need to delink this process and the discussion from all forms of religion and "god's will". What happens on the planet is not a matter of religion or the will of various gods. It is a matter of physics, of how Cosmos actually works, how nature actually functions and how we through the power of our free will do or do not work with these Cosmically present energies. The big tipoff is that working **with** the energies, as opposed to working against them, produces systems that sustain life and evolution, and **they makes sense!**

Thirdly, this process actually involves the Cosmic Energy **which, for the lack of a more scientifically appropriate name, we call Goodwill**. For many eons, we have not had the knowledge and hence the appropriate language to metaphorize the actions of these identifiable Cosmic Energies, so we had to resort to all sorts of mystical metaphors and mythological tales to describe what was happening quite normally and naturally in Cosmos. Hence, at the birth of Christ (which is the name we have designated for the embodiment in this dimension of the cosmic energy we call Love) we had Angels flying around singing "Peace on Earth, Goodwill to men!" **Peace on Earth, and Goodwill to men will unfold as synthetic aspects of evolution on this planet as we start going along with, rather than against, these Forces of Cosmos.**

Fourthly, those of us who understand these principles at least to some degree, need to start expressing them as thoughtforms in our thinking, speech and interactions with our brothers and sisters. **We call this cementing space.** We need to "think" these ideas into manifestation through the heart. This is the only way they can be materialized into new systems of Government, Economics and Human Relations. If we want to have a world of Equality and Freedom for ALL, we have to build it. Energy follows thought! Let's work harder.
